Ages: Preschool thru Grade 1

July 5-8 Flower Power:

Children will be looking closely at different flowers and plants in our area, labeling them by name, dissecting them and learning about their different parts.

July 12-15 All Creatures Great and Small:

Children will be exposed to the wide variety of animals in our region and learn about their habitat. We'll be hiking to examine animal tracks and their scat to identify the animal.

July 19-22 Soccer:

Children will learn basic skills needed for soccer and the rules of the sport. A great opportunity for team play.

July 26-29 Art:

Children will have the opportunity to work with clay, paint, beads, and more and will incorporate the natural environment into their art projects. We will finish the week tie-dyeing t-shirts.

Aug 2-5 Stream Stomp:
