

This September marks the long anticipated release of Storm Shadow's new ski/snowboard film "Water To Wine." Two premieres are scheduled for the Gallatin Valley. The first premiere is Wednesday, September 8th at MSU's Procrastinator Theater. Shows times at 830, 930, and 1030PM. The second premiere is Friday September 17th at Choppers Bar & Grill in the Big Sky Town Center. There will be an all ages show at 7PM and a 21+ show at 9PM. All tickets are available at the door.

Filmed entirely in South West MT and featuring some of the area's most innovative skiers and snowboarders, "Water To Wine" offers a rare glimpse of what these mountains have to offer.
